The Speakers: Robert & Sammy Mikulski

Sammy: By age three, Sammy could be heard singing on Northwest Indiana radio station WJOB. Since then her career has expanded to include over 50 productions, playing such roles as the narrator in Joseph and the Amazing Technicolor Dreamcoat, Rhett in Pump Boys and Dinettes, Oolie/Donna in City of Angels (Best actress Award – Excellence in Theater Foundation), Florence in Chess, Paula in The Goodbye Girl, Broadway on Broadway and New York's City Center. In addition to releasing two solo CDs, shortly after 9/11, Sammy co-wrote and co-produced a fund-raising CD entitled "We Are One" utilizing over 400 school-aged children. Sammy has taught musical theater in public schools, performing arts centers, and at Indiana State University. While living on the East Coast of the United States, Sammy and her husband co-founded a performing arts school which is still going strong today.

Robert: Rob began playing the piano at age 7 and started working in music ministry at age 16. He did his undergraduate work at the American Conservatory of Music in Chicago, Illinois with an emphasis in organ and education. His graduate and postgraduate work was done at the University of Illinois in Urbana with an emphasis in conducting. Rob's teachers include: G. Nicholas Bullat, Thomas Wisniewski, Ian Hopson, Leonard Bernstein, and Leonard Slatkin. In addition to working in the church, Rob spent eleven years conducting on Broadway in New York City.
